Like many places in Chester County, the Mill at Anselma is site to Native American history. In fact, Route 401/Conestoga Road was originally a Lenape trail!

In honor of Native American legacy, three trails are named after the Lenape clans dwelling in this area. The fourth trail follows the historic 19th century railroad bed that went through Anselma.
