  - Upgraded security system in Wagon Barn
  - Replaced manufacturer discontinued heat detectors in Mill and House
  - ► Wagon Barn exterior gray doors repaired, and new hardware installed, subterranean windows restored, three post office windowsills repaired
  - Grounds: cleaned up downed trees, mowing, repaired doors to shed, pond leak repaired, raking
  - Chicken Coop scraped and repainted
